

Sanctuary Worship Guidelines(COVID-19) as of July 12, 2020

- 1) We will hold two services, one from 9:00 to 9:45 am and one from 10:30 to 11:15 am.
- 2) Facemasks will be required. We will have a supply available for anyone needing one.
- 3) Hand Sanitizer will be made available. Please use it.
- 4) Special music will be offered for each service. No Choir or congregational singing.
- 5) Bulletins will be placed in the pews. If you touch a bulletin, please take it with you as you depart.
- 6) Offering baskets will be in the Narthex.
- 7) Sharing of the Peace will be done by remaining in place and making signs of friendship such as waving, “prayer hands,” or peace sign.
- 8) Children will remain with their family unit in the pew for Children’s Time. Their message will be delivered from the chancel.
- 9) Seating will be every other row, with rows designated for each service. Ushers will be used to seat and dismiss. Two family units per row maximum, as marked.
- 10) At the close of each service, dismissal will start with the back pew and then move forward with the front pew being dismissed last.
- 11) When you are dismissed, please exit the building promptly so the pews can be prepared for the next service. If you wish to speak with other members, please do so outside only.
- 12) No coffee will be available or Fellowship Time.
- 13) Water Fountains will be turned off.
- 14) No Sunday School at this time, either adult or child.
- 15) Communion will use pre-packaged communion cups for each Communion Sunday.
- 16) Commonly touched surfaces will be disinfected between the two services.
